Benefits of adopting Read Write Inc. across a trust

With our package of training and support, CEOs can be sure that in their schools:

We provide trust leaders with an analysis of school-by-school data every half-term. From this, we agree actions to accelerate pupils' progress focusing on any school where progress has stalled.

Steps to booking training and support

2. Check costs and details of training, below. We offer a fixed 25% discount for all MATs - large and small. (This is held until December 2022.)
3. Check costs of resource below. OUP offers 30% discount on all resources while the Trust is signed up to the MAT Training plan.

We will then:

1. Ask you to provide further details about the schools in your trust.
2. Email possible times for an RMT lead to meet with your CEO and leaders. We are booking these two months ahead.
3. For trusts with five or more schools, arrange a meeting with headteachers to explain the commitments, below. We are booking these three months ahead.
4. Book dates for training and support with you. Depending upon the number of schools needing training in each tranche, we are booking four to five months ahead.
5. Once dates for training have been agreed, OUP will ensure the best value package for each school.

10 commitments

It is important that headteachers agree to implement Read Write Inc. with fidelity. Headteachers will need to appoint a Reading leader from EY or KS1 who will:

1. Organise weekly practice sessions using the online training subscription
2. Coach teachers during lessons (Reading leaders do not teach their own group)
3. Assess and track pupils' reading progress every half term
4. Group pupils according to progress
5. Organise for the slowest progress pupils to be tutored for 10 minutes every day
6. Ensure the Read Write Inc. Phonics programme is taught in full (including writing) for one hour five days a week in Year 1 and above, and 20 minutes rising to 40 minutes in Reception
7. Ensure that Read Write Inc. decodable storybooks and Virtual Classroom links are sent home for pupils to practise every week
8. Ensure that eligible pupils complete the whole programme, including pupils in older year groups who are not reading at a level commensurate with their age
9. Work with the designated RMT trainer on Development days and remote progress meetings, and attend Reading leader meeting with others from the trust
10. Share assessment data with Ruth Miskin Training every half-term

Conditions

1. Our trust model is successful when all schools in the trust adopt the programme. We agree to 90% adoption in a few circumstances. (If this isn't possible, schools can book training individually [here.](#))
2. Trusts that support schools financially ask headteachers to sign a 'memorandum of understanding' listing the 10 points above.
3. Trusts will need to appoint a trust-wide reading leader who co-ordinates the training plan, reviews data and school's fidelity with the RMT leader.

Cost of training and support

Support for trust leaders

Half-termly trust leader meetings (free)

An RMT leader is assigned to the trust. They provide a half-termly report following an analysis of pupil's reading accuracy and fluency across the trust, and the schools' fidelity to the programme. This one-hour meeting focuses on actions to accelerate pupils' progress.

Joint reading leader meetings (half-termly two-hour remote sessions at £300)

These meetings, led by an RMT leader focus on training, practice and coaching based on half-termly data.

Please note: many of our trusts book an additional two Development Days in the first two years.

Details of school training and support

Leadership implementation day

The leadership implementation day sets the scene. The trainer shows the headteacher, deputy, reading leader and reception teacher the systems necessary to get going. This does not require a school closure.

Training day

The trainer shows staff how to teach reading from the moment a child steps into your school – whatever their age. This requires all staff to attend, so is likely to need a closure day.

Development Days

The trainer works with the reading leader, teachers and pupils while the school is open.

The trainer shows the reading leader how to:

- analyse data
- check groups are homogeneous
- organise one-to-one tuition
- run weekly practice sessions
- coach reading teachers during lessons
- set online training pathways
- use the Virtual Classroom at school and at home.

One-hour remote progress meetings

The trainer meets with the reading leader and headteacher via Teams or Zoom every term.

They discuss recent progress data, decide the next steps for practice and coaching, and the actions to support pupils who are receiving tutoring.

Online training subscription

The Online Subscription supports both teachers and pupils.

Bite-size training films increase teacher's confidence

- Teachers plan and practise their next day's lesson
- Tutors practise tutoring the slowest progress readers – including pupils with SEND
- Tutors follow the Fresh Start training to support any struggling readers in Years 5 and 6
- The reading leader creates training pathways that matches individual's training needs
- The reading leader uses films to train new staff – avoiding the cost and wait for regional training

In-action films

- Teachers watch experienced teachers teach every activity using our behaviour strategies

Virtual Classroom films accelerate pupils' progress

These are used:

- During lessons to assess pupils' progress and improve teaching
- For extra individual or small group practice
- For extra practice at home

Spelling and nursery training will also be included early next year.

Cost of resources

Start-up resources pack
